### **The Chinese Secondary Copper Smelter and Refining Industry (Including the latest Chinese secondary copper smelter/refinery projects)**

Recycling has become an essential and crucial part of the copper industry not only as a complement to primary supply to meet future copper demand but as an important contributor to a sustainable circular economy.

China is the most important copper-producing country with a high proportion of world smelter/refinery production. In addition to new primary smelting projects, many secondary smelting projects have been commissioned in China in recent years. In order to track and update developments in the Chinese secondary copper smelting industry, ICSG commissioned BGRIMM Lilan Consulting to undertake a “Survey of Trends in Secondary Copper Smelter and Refining Industries in China”.

This report contains a detailed overview of the Chinese secondary copper smelter and refining industries, including a production outlook up to 2028 (see table of contents below). An excel file with detailed information on Chinese secondary copper smelters and refineries on a plant by plant basis, with production capacity projections up to 2028, is also included.
