China is the most important copper-producing country with a high proportion of world smelter/refinery production. In addition to new primary smelting projects, many secondary smelting projects have been commissioned in China in recent years. In order to track and update developments in the Chinese secondary copper smelting industry, ICSG commissioned BGRIMM Lilan Consulting to undertake a "Survey of Trends in Secondary Copper Smelter and Refining Industries in China".
