



## New Report on China Copper Mining Industry

As China is the world's biggest copper using country and the largest refined copper producer it is important to continually assess the development of its copper ore resources. In the last few years China has been investing in overseas copper mining projects to secure feed for its expanding copper smelting/refining industry but not much is known about the development of the country's own copper resources. Availability of information on the copper mines currently operating or being developed in China is limited and therefore this study, prepared for the International Copper Study Group by BGRIMM Lilan Consulting Corp., aims at providing a detailed overview of the Chinese copper mining industry, from exploration to project development and actual production as well as Chinese investment in overseas mines.
